Frequently Asked Questions

When did this transition take place?

Beauty for Ashes was merged with the Muncie Mission effective January 1st, 2018.

Will there be one board of directors?

The Muncie Mission board of directors will govern the combined organization. Stan Horner, President of the Beauty for Ashes board, has joined the Muncie Mission board.

How will the organization be led?

Frank Baldwin, the current Chief Executive Officer of Muncie Mission will be the lead staff person. Marie Seitz, the Executive Director for Beauty for Ashes will serve as the Program Director for the Women's Transitional Housing program known as Beauty for Ashes in Alexandria. The Beauty for Ashes employees are Muncie Mission employees effective January 1, 2018.

What is the merged organization named?

Both Muncie Mission and Beauty for Ashes have significant name recognition with stakeholders throughout East Central Indiana, and they stand for quality programs delivered with excellence. However, Muncie Mission Ministries will now be the official name of the organization, and Beauty for Ashes will continue as a program offered by the Mission.

Where is Beauty for Ashes located now that the merger is complete?

The program of Beauty for Ashes will still operate out of the transitional home in Alexandria. The Program Director will report to the Chief Executive Officer of the Mission but work in Alexandria. All payroll and benefits will be administered by Muncie Mission.

How does one make a donation to Beauty for Ashes?
